


# Sunday Scripture Readings



## May 1, 2022

Acts 9:1-6 (7-20) On the road to Damascus, Saul sees a blinding light and is converted.  
Psalm 30 O Lord, you brought me up from the grave; my soul praises you.  
Revelation 5:11-14 The choirs of heaven sing: Worthy is the Lamb that was slain! Amen!  
John 21:1-19 A miraculous catch of fish; Jesus tells Simon Peter: Feed my sheep.

## May 8, 2022

Acts 9:36-43 Peter raises Tabitha from the dead; many believe in the Lord.  
Psalm 23 The Lord is my shepherd, leading, protecting, and feeding me.  
Revelation 7:9-17 The redeemed worship at the throne of the Lamb, their shepherd.  
John 10:22-30 Jesus says: My sheep hear my voice; I know them and they follow me.

## May 15, 2022

Acts 11:1:1-18 Peter has a vision about unclean food; God's gift of life is for all.  
Psalm 148 Praise the Lord, all creation! God is exalted in heaven and earth.  
Revelation 21:1-6 A new heaven and earth; a holy city; God's home is among mortals.  
John 13:31-35 Jesus gives a new commandment: love one another as I love you.

## May 22, 2022

Acts 16:9-15 Hearing Paul in Macedonia, Lydia and her household are baptized.  
Psalm 67 May God be gracious and bless us; let the whole earth praise God.  
Revelation 21:10, 21:22-22-5 A vision of the holy city; the river of life flows from God's throne.  
John 13:23-29 Jesus says: Keep my word; the Spirit will teach you; I give you peace.

## May 26, 2022—Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11 Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascends into heaven.  
Psalm 47 Clap, shout, and sing with joy: the Lord reigns over all the earth.  
Ephesians 1:15-23 Christ is seated at God's right hand, above every earthly power.  
Luke 24:44-53 Jesus interprets the Scriptures; then he is carried up into heaven.

## May 29, 2022

Acts 16:16-34 Paul and Silas are arrested, but an earthquake destroys the prison.  
Psalm 97 The Lord reigns over all the earth; light dawns for the righteous.  
Revelation 22:12-14 The Lord says: See, I am coming soon. Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!  
John 17:20-26 Jesus prays that his disciples may be one as he is one with the Father.
